ABSTRACT

In many issues in dentistry, including Endodontics, there is inherent uncertainty. Some of it is scientific; clear evidence based on data is often lacking. There are many unknowns in our field, for example when it comes to which treatment is the best to preserve pulp vitality in the long run, and to what factors are of true clinical importance for the outcome of RCT and tooth survival. Some of the uncertainty may also be personal, or practical. Do we as clinicians reflect on uncertainty? How should we address it? Can uncertainty be reduced, or does it simply have to be managed? How do we make wise decisions in the face of uncertainty? Another matter in which we often feel uncertain is differential diagnosis of persistent tooth pain. Why are root-filled teeth sometimes painful? What is the value of diagnostic tests, and can diagnosis be improved with more testing?
